12:27:37 From Jennifer Burbidge : Tony T, I believe the 50% capacity refers to indoor facilities (pools, etc.) - someone correct me if I'm wrong? The document we are looking at now finally clarifies that Outdoor youth team sports and outdoor adult recreational team sports:

- In phase 2 team practice can resume if players are limited to groups of 5 in separate parts of the field separated by a buffer zone, and if the practice can follow social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet between players with no contact. Each league or club must publish and follow a return to play safety plan. Parents

and household members must not congregate on the sidelines during practice.

- In phase 3 teams playing at sporting facilities with more than one field limitations on public gatherings will be in place for each individual field rather than for the entire multiple field facility. Again, each league must publish and follow have a return to play safety plan.
