

2022 Session—Week 9 Public Hearings/“Executive Sessions” (Committee Votes)

Monday, March 7, 2022

House Finance Committee – 8 AM – Hearings and Executive Sessions scheduled on several bills, including **ESB 5849** concerning tax incentives and **ESSB 5980**, providing permanent tax relief for small businesses to mitigate structural deficiencies in Washington’s Business & Occupation (B&O) tax. *MONITOR*.

Senate Ways & Means – 5 PM – Hearings on **ESHB 1914**, expanding the motion picture and TV production competitiveness program; **2SHB 1918**, reducing emissions from outdoor power equipment; and **SHB 2018**, creating a three-day shop local sales and use tax holiday during the Labor Day Weekend. *MONITOR*.

Wednesday, March 9, 2022

Senate Ways & Means – 12 PM – Executive Session votes scheduled on **ESHB 1846**, providing a tax preference for rural and non-rural data centers; **ESHB 1914**, expanding the motion picture and TV production competitiveness program; **2SHB 1918**, reducing emissions from outdoor power equipment; **SHB 2018**, creating a three-day shop local sales and use tax holiday during the Labor Day Weekend; and **HB 1990**, concerning a sales tax deferral for five (5) designated Interstate 405/State Route 167 projects.
