## Housing Stability & Affordability - 1/27/2020 1:30 PM

#### **Public Hearing**

- 1. **SB 6334** Concerning urban housing supply. *This bill is worthy of SUPPORT authorizes but does not mandate additional actions cities can take to accommodate density.*
- 2. **SB 6364** Incentivizing smaller, more affordable single-family home development through impact fee schedule modifications. *MONITOR*.
- 3. **SB 6387** Accelerating housing infrastructure investments by adjusting impact fee timelines. (Hearing is on the Proposed Substitute.). *MONITOR* though change from 10 years to six (6) years may be of CONCERN.
- 4. SB 6388 Concerning impact fees for multifamily and single-family housing. MONITOR.
